To help improve cancer pain management and cancer pain experience among Asian American women in the USA!



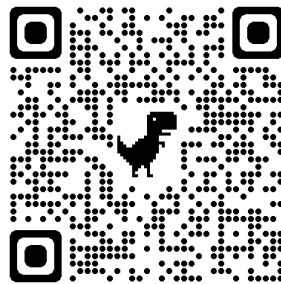
JOIN US IF YOU:

ABOUT THE STUDY

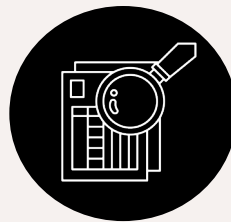
CAI study is an online study and does not involve medication and travel.
